RECAP BY LINDA PELTON:

Waltz Boot Camp was a resounding success with 31 couples attending from around the state and a few couples from outside of Texas. Curt and Tammy spent the first day extensively working on proper frame, and then proceeded to work on whisks, chasses (to semi and to banjo), maneuver, spin turns, box finish and hovers. By Saturday we were working on telemarks, hover telemarks, and double reverse spins. Sunday morning included the weave, outside change, in and runs, and then we had a quickie lesson on the proper position for banjo and sidecar.

Everyone that attended worked very hard at improving their waltz technique. As Curt said, we will all fall back to bad habits if we don't consciously practice our new skills.

Friday and Saturday night Curt cued all request rounds which consisted of mostly phase 4 and 5 dances with a few phase 3 dances sprinkled in. There was also a very early optional half hour of phase 5 and 6 dances that were cued just before the evening review session. Everyone had as much dancing as they wanted and Curt did a fabulous job getting to all the requests on the request list.

Next year Curt and Tammy will be back for a Tango Boot Camp which will be held back in Fort Worth at Swingtime Center. Flyers will be available from either Helen and Glen Arceneaux or JL and Linda Pelton at any Harvest Holiday dance.
