Tips:

Try to keep the dancing circle as large as the room will permit. If crowded, and inner circle will form and it will be important to keep the "lane" of each circle defined for the flow of dancing.

Ladies- If attending an all day event for the first time, make sure you have more than one pair of shoes. For dancing comfort, you may elect to change shoes for a comfortable evening dance!

Festivals have vendors! Expect an opportunity to purchase dance attire/shoes/accessories!

Have your contact information on any "take along" items. Also be prepared to see lots of similar (black) dance bags and/or totes - so mark yours for easy identification. Also remember people other than dancers can be in and around your things especially at a large facility.

Take preprinted cards or paper to exchange email or phone numbers with dancers you meet - bring a camera!
