Note from Ron & Marilou Webb — As many of you already know, Ron has been diagnosed with 6th Cranial Nerve Palsy which causes Double Vision. No known cause has been determined yet, but he will see a Neuro-Ophthalmologist at UTSW Medical School on Monday the 19th of June. Hopefully, we will gain some insight into the cause, and can start on the solution.

During the testing for the Double Vision, an MRI revealed an "Acoustic Neuroma", which is a benign Tumor that grows on the nerve leading from the Brain Stem to the Inner Ear, that controls balance and hearing. Although these tumors are rare, they are the most frequent type of brain tumor. These are typically very slow growing tumors but we have

decided to go to Johns Hopkins Hospital on July 25-27 for evaluation and recommendations on what to do that would be best for us and our lifestyle. In the meantime, we are requesting your prayers. On June 22, Marilou and I leave for a 12 day
