If you haven't already renewed your Harvest Holiday membership, now is a great time to do it! Beginning with the February dance, membership is an even better value. February 8th, 2009, and dances thereafter, the guest fee will be \$14 per couple. Assuming you attend monthly dances February though November (traditionally December is a free dance), you would spend \$140 for the ten dances; add the Spring Rounds, May Mini Fest and Autumn Rounds at \$14 times three gives you at total cost of \$182. By paying your \$70 per couple membership fee at or before the February dance, you will save \$112 this year. You can attend the Harvest Holiday Festival in November with the savings!!
