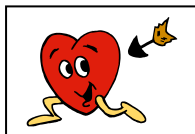

ALMOND GLAZED SUGAR COOKIES

(from Lorraine Gonya)

Ingredients – Cookies

- ◆ 1 cup Butter (2 sticks)
- ◆ ¾ cup Sugar
- ◆ 1 teaspoon almond extract
- ◆ 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ◆ ½ teaspoon baking power
- ◆ ¼ teaspoon salt

Ingredients – Glaze

- ◆ 2 cups powdered sugar
- ◆ 1 teaspoon almond extract
- ◆ 6 teaspoons water

Decoration

- ◆ Sliced almonds

Directions-Cookies

- Heat oven to 400°.
- Combine butter, sugar and almond extract in large mixer bowl.
- Beat at medium speed, scraping bowl often, until creamy (1-2 minutes).
- Reduce speed to low, and add all remaining cookie ingredients.
- Beat until well mixed (1-2 minutes)
- Roll dough into 1-inch balls.
- Place 2 inches apart on cookie sheet.
- Flatten balls to ¼ inch thickness with the bottom of a buttered glass dipped in sugar.
- Bake for 9 minutes or until edges are very lightly browned.
- Cool 1 minute; remove from cookie sheets, and cool completely.

Directions-Glaze

- Stir together all glaze ingredients in small bowl with wire whisk.
- Decorate cooled cookies with glaze and sliced almonds.

Makes about 3-1/2 dozen cookies.
