Notes from Local Round Dance Leaders

Karen & Ed Gloodt:

Well, not much to report. We had a second dance at the Pacesetters' Ballroom in Madill. Masks are requested, and we limit attendance to about a dozen couples for distancing. Most of the dancers wear masks and bring their own water and snacks. We dance phase 3-5 from about 2:00-5:00.

Our next Madill dance will be on Saturday, November 21, with the same restrictions, and we are at our maximum number for distancing at the November dance (everyone has been before). [NOTE: Check with Ed & Karen for up-to-date info if you are interested in going.] We continue to do teaches/reviews here at the house 2-3 times a month.

We hope that Swingtime will open in January, but who knows!

We will be cueing at a New Year's Eve square and round dance sponsored by T Square Gadabouts at Swingtime Center (depending on approval by Swingtime and City of Forest Hill) – 7:00 p.m. early rounds; 8:00 p.m. Grand March, with Vernon Jones and Bobby Willis on squares.

Also, the January Jewel Phase II-IV Festival in Shreveport (January 22-23) is still scheduled to take place – see Festival listing below.

Christine & Theron Hixson:

Our Tuesday group is small, but we are social distancing, wearing masks, etc. Because we are still not dancing on Wednesday, we are meeting 30 minutes early on Tuesday and dancing some of the harder Ph. V and VI dances previously danced on Wednesday.

We just completed basic waltz lessons, but there is nowhere for the students to go and dance. So, at the request of the students, we are starting a new session and will be dancing basic waltz for the first half of the lesson, and then teaching basic two-step the second part of the lesson.

On a more personal note, we had to miss one Monday and two Tuesday nights because I was admitted to the hospital via the ER on Monday, August 17, had numerous tests (MRI, CTA, doppler – and of course Covid-19), and was scheduled for carotid artery surgery on Friday, August 21. I was in pre-op waiting on the surgeon (had already been prepped and signed all the consent

forms), when the surgeon came with an entourage and told me the surgery had to be postponed. There's a lot more to the story that I won't go into here! So, I was discharged to go home, and then the surgery was rescheduled for Tuesday September 1. All went well, and I came home on September 2, and I'm doing well. **Just a reminder to everyone**, if it seems like your body is giving you a warning that something is wrong, take heed and get it taken care of. My warning was a five-minute loss of vision in my eye – so thankful my ophthalmologist saw me within an hour, recognized the problem, and then got the ball rolling for the rest of the saga.

Jack & Sharie Kenny:

We're still projecting startup in January [both clubs], but subject to change, of course. Sigh.

JL & Linda Pelton:

Dance Arounds are still not dancing, and we have no idea when the Sam Johnson Center (formerly the senior center) will open up for us. It is a similar story for Carpenter Rec Center and beginning classes. They are not booking any "couples" type classes for the spring. They are only booking "single" participant classes. Fortunately, all our dancers are well with only a few aches and pains. For several, it's giving them an opportunity to recover from hip surgery and a serious calf injury before getting back to dancing. A very few have ventured out to a dance or two, but most of us are staying close to home.

Ken Gartlir Update

Ken is continuing with his chemo treatments for AML. He has just completed his second round of chemo and is now at home recuperating. He will be going for a check-up on Tuesday, November 3, and it will then be determined when he will start his third chemo treatment. Each chemo treatment is administered in the hospital and takes four days, and then he has to stay until his immune system recovers to a certain level. That means he stays in the hospital for approximately two to three weeks.

All things considered, Ken remains in "good" health and good spirits, is regaining his appetite and strength, and has a good prognosis.

As has been said before, he is being treated at a great medical facility and has an excellent medical team taking care of him, and of course has wonderful support from June, his family, and friends.
